5. Evidence of Success:

Apart from academic sessions, the institution conducted various online competitions and activities which helped the students to nurture their inner self and to improve the environment during the locked down period.

The different interactive programmes aimed at Women Empowerment had a visible impact and result in that all sessions were characterized by dynamic and active participation of students. Many of the participants responded to ideas and issues raised in the respective sessions and raised relevant questions thereby leading to fruitful dissemination of creative awareness about attitudinal and behavioral changes for which such sessions were organized. Thus it can be seen that the programmes achieved their desired aim of impacting lively and vigorous awareness about empowerment which is absolutely necessary for creating an equitable society.

6. Problems Encounters and Resources Required:

Since the only way to conduct the programmes was online mode due to the spread of Corona virus, various communicating software such as Google meet, Zoom etc were used for the purpose. The major issues faced during the sessions were the network range issues and unavailability of supporting digital gadgets. Most of the students belong to the hilly area and majority of them belong to the middle class family.

Proper Internet Connectivity in all parts of the state and easy availability of digital gadgets and proper guidelines for the usage are found to be the requirement to make online sessions like webinars and hands on session more productive.

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BEST PRACTICE II

1. Title of the Practice: Direct help in times of the Pandemic

2. Objectives of the Practice:

- To strongly participate in fight against Covid -19
- To provide support and help to the Society by humanitarian interventions
- To train the students especially NCC cadets and NSS volunteers on various activities for prevention of the deadly virus
- To provide online learning gadgets to enable the students to continue their education through online learning

3. The Context

During the early days of the outbreak of Covid 19 Pandemic onwards, the MG College Fraternity comprising students and the staff undertook many humanitarian interventions in order to help the people in distress. The pandemic situation necessitated the constant use of sanitizers and mask as the very part of day to day existence. The requirement for trained volunteers to serve in Covid duties were met by our NSS volunteers.

4. The Practice

The students in general and the volunteers in particular involved themselves in the production and distribution of both sanitizers and masks as a result of which large number of people could collect the essential new items in their daily life free of cost as part of the new normal. 10000 masks were supplied by students as a combined effort of NSS, Women Cell and Bhumithra Sena club. First year NSS volunteers produced more than 1000 masks and NCC cadets produced 700 masks in 7 days and they were also distributed in their locality. It was an example of concrete and direct help as well as a clear instance of spreading awareness related to effective preventive and safety measures against the threat posed by Corona Virus. All NSS volunteers completed the training - Basics of Covid-19 (Ministry Of Youth Affairs and Sports) during the last week of April, 2020 and registered in the Kerala Government Sannadhasena Portal.

When the active Covid cases crossed more tham one lakh in the state, College Hostel was set up as First Line Treatment Center. The hostel inmates were sent home and the hostel was used by many Covid patients.

When the Government announced the SSLC and Higher Secondary Public examinations, NSS volunteers of our college extended their service at Iritty Higher Secondary School , to clean the classrooms according to Covid-19 protocol .

When the problem of pandemic became serious, the need for blood pressure monitors was high in the case of people who were severely affected by it. The students and the college rose in response to the magnitude of the problem and using own resources as well as with the contribution of well wishers, took part in oxy meter challenge. A total of two digital blood pressure monitors were distributed to different patients who were in urgent need of these gadgets.

When conventional classroom teaching had to be suspended in favour of online mode, it was found out that many students belonging to economically weak section of the society did not possess electronic gadgets such as smart phones and T V. Here also, the students and the staff of the college, with the help of alumni carried out a commendable service by identifying the people who lacked these facilities and supplying them with television and smart phones which hugely helped these beneficiaries to access the online mode of education satisfactorily. Altogether, 5 television sets and 4 smart phones of high quality were freely distributed to the needy people of the nearby society.

At the time of the massive vaccination drive o contain the pandemic, many students of our college including NCC cadets NSS volunteers served as volunteers in different vaccination camps organized in Kannur District.

Apart from that, all the staff of the institution contributed one month salary in five monthly installments to Kerala Government to fight against the COVID, all the staff. When Government decided to reimburse the deducted one-month salary after a specific period, some teachers has contributed single installments voluntarily.

The Teachers' Association has contributed several equipments like washing machine and other electronic devices to the Covid treatment center, when it is highly needed.

The finance department has submitted a proposal of deducting a six-day salary of all categories of government employees in a month and the deduction would be continued for five months.

Construction of two houses is going on with the financial aid from the College staff and students. One house is proposed as Snehaveedu by NSS in association with Indiraji Memorial Charitable Educational Society, Iritty. The project started in 2018 at it is 75% completed. Another is proposed for a student of our institution as part of College Silver Jubilee celebration and completed only 35%.



5. Evidence of Success

When normal activities in social life and usual classroom teaching came to a standstill on account of the lock down induced by the Covid -19 Pandemic, Mahatma Gandhi College, resorted to the practice of distributing handmade masks and sanitizers to the fellow people, TV, smart phones etc to the students belonging to the vicinity of the college with the money collected from the staff as well as with the co- operation of the alumni of the college. The beneficiaries of this intervention were unable to access online classes because they had no suitable devices for it. Later the students and their parents informed the college authorities that they could greatly benefit from these devices donated to them because it helped them to access online classes effectively so that they could continue with the process of education in the 'new normal' circumstances. Thus timely help in the manner of providing them with electronic gadgets turned out to be an inspiration to study well instead of creating addiction to

electronic devices. So this best practice proved to be the ideal intervention for strengthening cause of education during the days of the pandemic.

6. Problem Encounters and Resources Required

The main difficulty faced was the to raise fund for the various activities. During the Pandemic many parents get jobless which adversely affect the studies of their children. So identifying the needy was found to ne dffiucyt,
