Both Parties are desirous of entering into this MoU to declare their respective intentions and to establish a basis of co-operation and collaboration between the Parties upon the terms as contained

3. OBJECTIVE

Both Parties, subject to the terms of this MoU and the laws, rules, regulations and national policies from time to time in force in each party's country, will'endeavour to strengthen, promote and develop cooperation between the Parties on the basis of equality and mutual

4. AREAS OF CO-OPERATION

- 4.1 Each Party will, subject to the laws, rules, regulations and national policies from time to time in force, governing the subject matter, endeavour to take the necessary steps to encourage and promote co-operation in the following areas:
 - a) Training and Placements of students;
 - b) Student internships;
 - c) Project Training for students:
 - d) Exchange of knowledge:
 - e) Industrial training and visit
 - f) Skill development programs
 - g) Outcome based training
 - h) R and D services
 - i) Faculty development programs
 - j) Guest Lectures
 - k) Any other areas of co-operation to be mutually agreed upon by the Parties from time to time.

For the purpose of implementing the co-operation in respect of any area in sub-clause 4.1 the Parties may enter into a legally binding agreement subject to terms and conditions as mutually agreed upon by the Parties.

5. FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

- 5.1 This MoU will not give rise to any financial obligation by one Party to the other.
- 5.2 There is no financial commitment on the part of the first party to take up any program. Second party can fix fees on mutually understanding for each service, it will be dealt separately.

6. CONFIDENTIALITY

6.1 Each Party shall undertake to observe the secrecy of confidential information received from or supplied to the other Parties during the period of implementation of this MoU or other agreements made pursuant to this MoU. For purposes of this MoU, "confidential information" means any information whether prior to or hereinafter disclosed by a Party (the Disclosing Party) to the other Parties (the Receiving Party) of this MoU involving technical, business, marketing, policy, knowhow, planning, project management and other information, data and/or solutions in any form, including but not limited to any information which is designated in writing to be confidential or by its nature intended to be for the knowledge of the Receiving Party or if orally given, is given in the

umstances of confidence.

- 6.2 All Parties agree that the provisions of this Clause shall continue to be binding between the Parties notwithstanding the termination of this MoU.
- This MOU does not include the exchange of lands between the two parties.

8. EFFECT OF MoU

This MoU serves only as a record of the Party intentions and does not constitute, and is not intended to constitute or create, obligations under domestic or international law and will not give rise to any legal process and will not be deemed to constitute or create any legally binding or enforceable obligations, expressed or implied.

ENTRY INTO EFFECT AND DURATION 9.

- 9.1 This MoU will come into effect on the date of signing and will remain in effect for a period of one (1) year.
- 9.2 This MoU may be extended for a further period as may be agreed in writing by the Parties.

10. REVISION, VARIATION, AMENDMENT AND TERMINATION

Any Party may request in writing a revision, variation or amendment of this MoU. Any such revision, variation or amendment agreed to by the Parties shall be in writing and shall form part of this MoU. Such revision, variation or amendment shall come into force on such date as may be determined by the Parties. Any party may terminate this MoU by giving six (6) months advance notice in writing to the other party. Any revision, variation, amendment, termination or expiration shall not prejudice the implementation of any project, activity or cooperation arising from or based on this MoU before or up to the date of such revision, variation or amendment.

11. SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES

Any difference or disputes between the Parties concerning the interpretation and/or implementation and/or application of any of the provisions of this MoU shall be settled amicably through mutual consultation and/or negotiations between the Parties without reference to any third party or international tribunal.
